New this year!

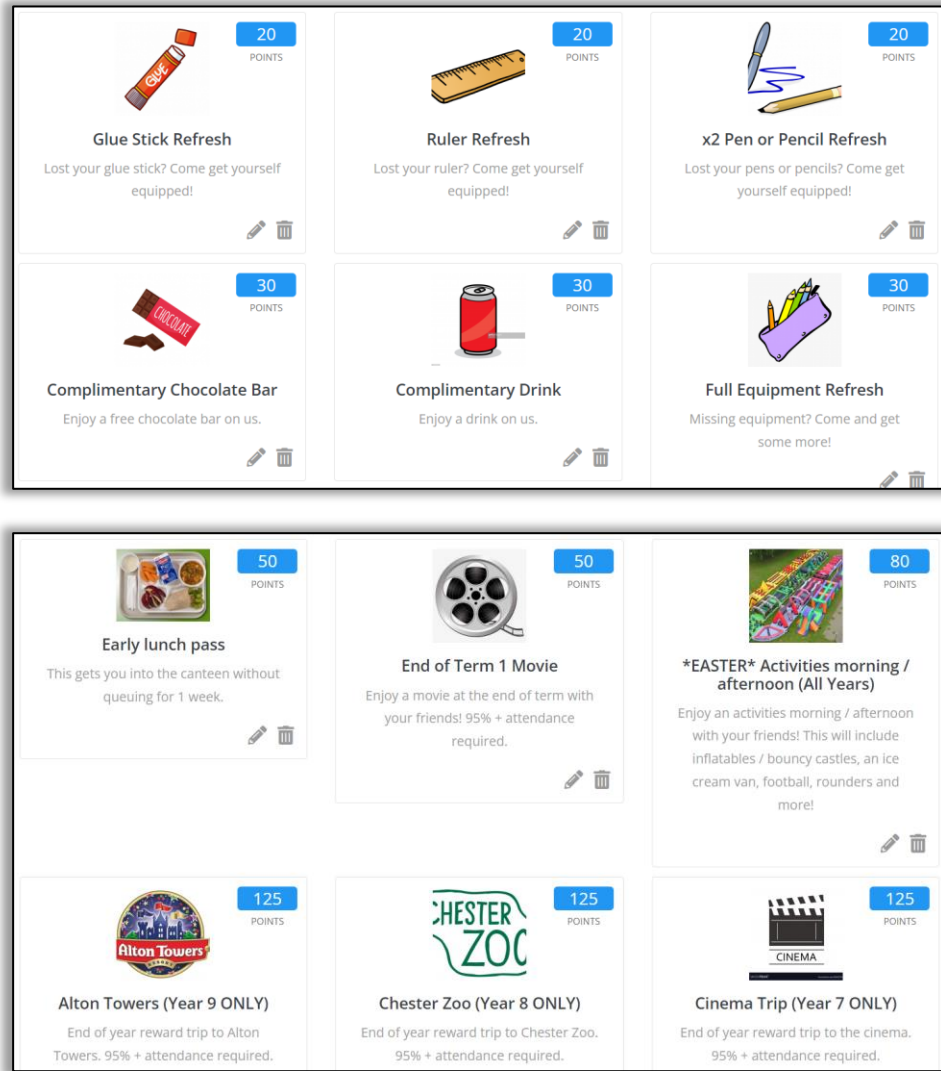
- Our core values must be central to our rewards and behaviour policy.

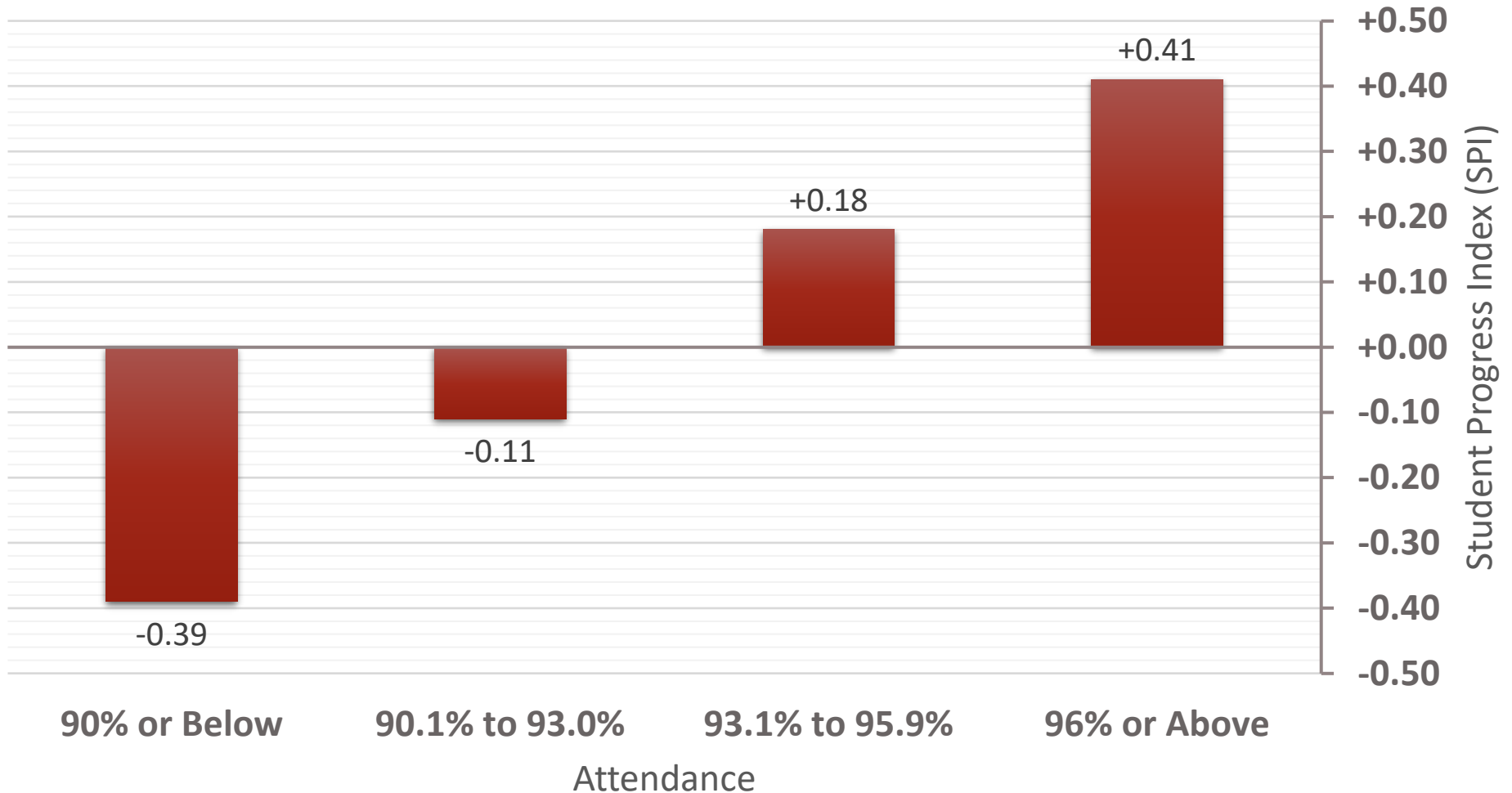

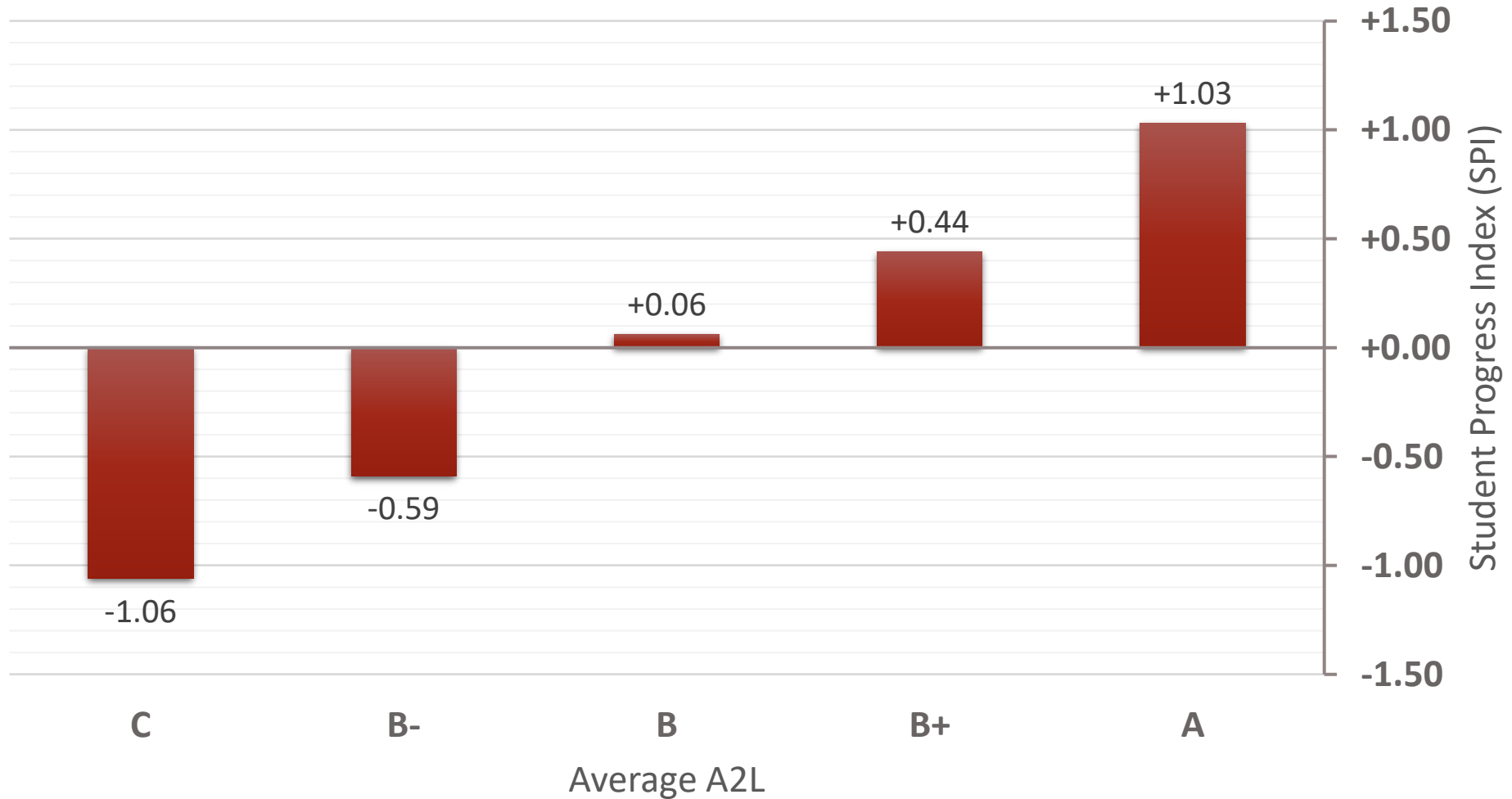
2023 Year 11 Students' Progress (SPI) by Attendance

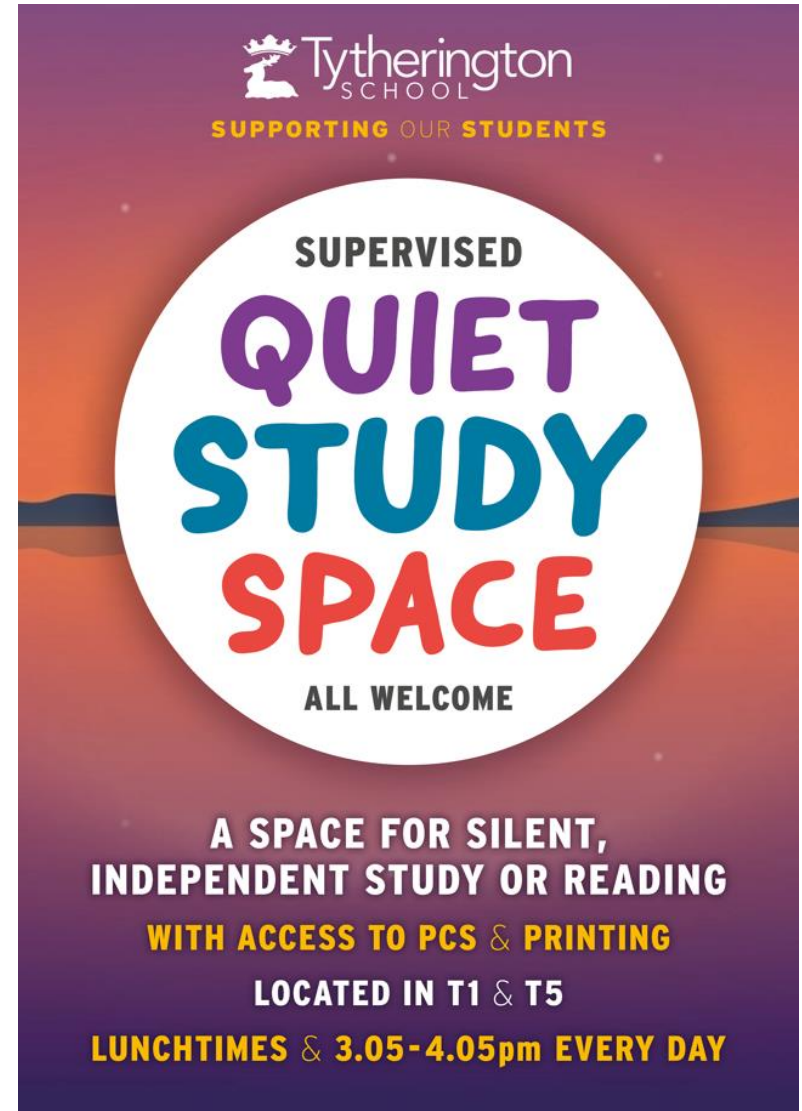

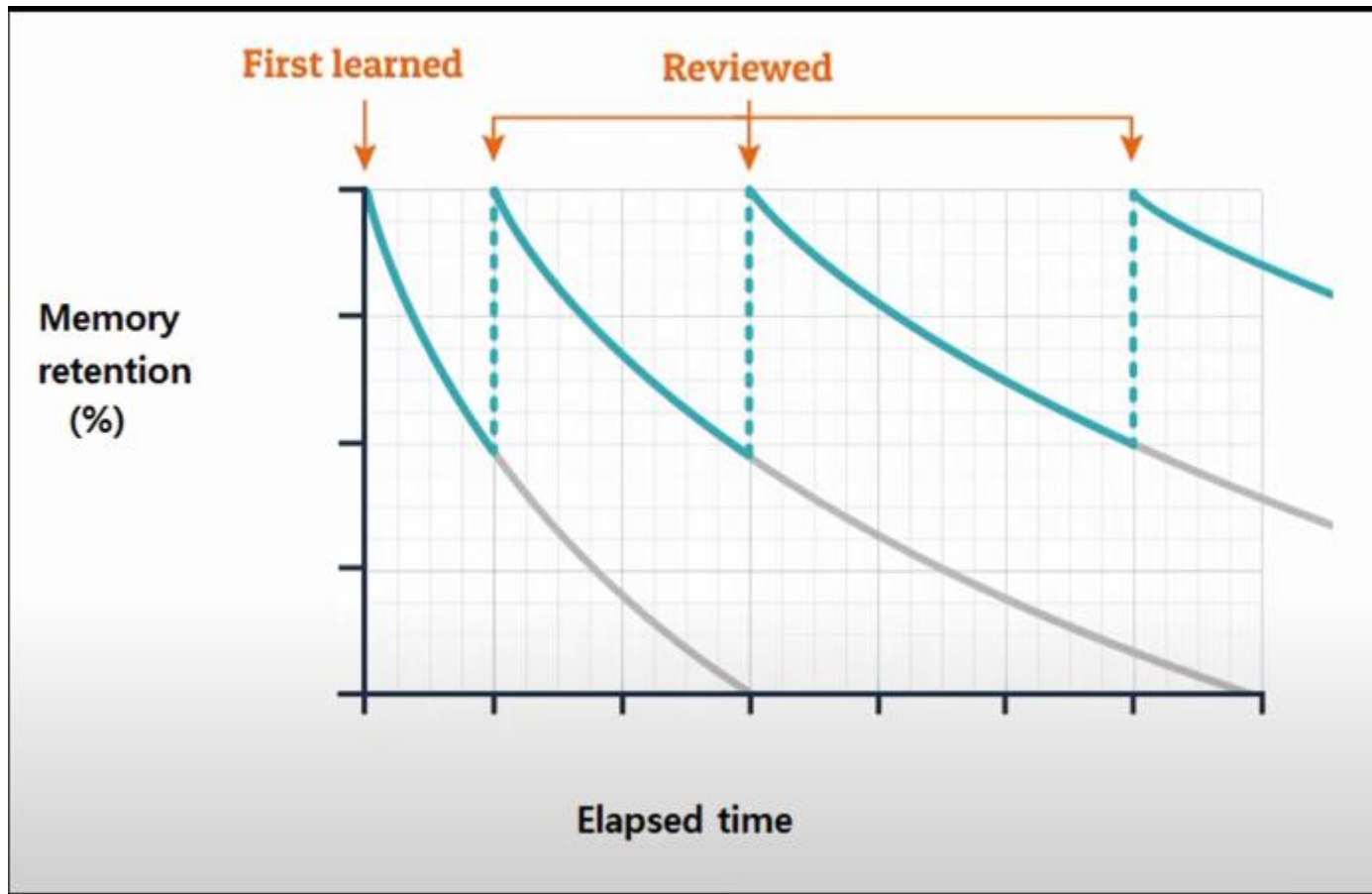

Via the website or app, simply log in once, using your normal school login, and begin reading; when you exit, your place is automatically bookmarked and you can begin where you stopped with just one click.

- Full-screen reading mode.
- Many ways to customize how eBooks are displayed - font style, font size, background colour, character/line spacing.
- Settings for dyslexia and night time reading.
- Your eBooks are available even after you've disconnected from the internet.
- Features such as highlighting sections of text, adding notes, dictionary, thesaurus and links to Google search results for selected words.
