Bronze (Yr9) and Silver (Yr10) Duke of Edinburgh's Award 2023/24 Applications Open

Dear Families,

I'm delighted to let you know that we are opening the application window for our Bronze (Year 9) and Silver (Year 10) Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DofE).

Why do DofE?

Doing DofE is a brilliant way for your young person to discover just how much they are capable of. It gives young people the chance to make new friends, follow their passions, learn new skills and make a difference in our community. Gaining a DofE Award is a great way to impress employers too. It's also non-competitive and a powerful way for every young person to build belief in themselves, whatever their background, interests and abilities.

How it works

There are three levels of DofE Award – Bronze, Silver and Gold. To achieve the Bronze and Silver awards, your child will need to complete four sections – Volunteering, Physical, Skills and the Expedition.

Students can choose what they would like to do for the first three sections, completing at least one hour of the activity per week for a set period of time (please see the timescale graphics below). The Expedition involves spending two/three days and one/two nights in the countryside (Bronze/Silver respectively), and again we'll make sure that our young people are fully prepared for it.





For the expedition element, we use an Outdoor Activities Provider that will provide full training and some expedition equipment, such as tents and stoves for cooking meals. This accounts for the majority of the cost of the award and you may wish to look at other options in the local area, such as Scouts, Guides, Cadets, etc.
