










2. Support your child to come in on time, every day

- Use a quiet space away from smartphones




Sparx Personalised Homework

Science – Thursday to Thursday





4. Discourage the over-use of Smartphones

- 'The mere presence of a smartphone can lower your brain capacity' (Ward et al, 2016)
- Extensive use of social media degrades attention and concentration skills
- 'Like' buttons make teenage lives a constant public popularity contest
- Monitor phone use and check settings
- Best antidote face to face interactions

- avoid talking negatively about the school, teachers or subjects in front of your children




AI & Education




Study published on the 19th June 2025 that involved brain scans of ChatGPT users and non-users during the task of responding to an essay title.

Key Messages about Al



- It's there to <u>help</u> you, not <u>be</u> you
- It should provide the least amount of help possible
- Beware of apps such as Gauth

Our Reward and Behaviour Policy





- Our core values are central to our rewards and behaviour policy.

Careers programme




- There is a Careers programme for years 7-13 (see website).
