HOW TO ENROL IN OUR SIXTH FORM



*Students can enrol in Sixth Form from
GCSE Results day on Thursday 20 August 2026*

There are 2 ways to enrol in Tytherington Sixth Form:

**1: Online (via your application portal
or the link on our website)**

2: Via a guidance meeting

We are asking students to enrol on 3 subjects or 3 plus an AS which is part of the academic enrichment programme. Or, if students have achieved all grades 8 and 9 at GCSE they can enrol for 4 subjects.

OPTION 1

ONLINE ENROLMENT

This option is **ONLY** if you are accepting the subjects from your offer letter and have met the entry requirements.

Log back into your Sixth Form application portal (a link will also be posted on the website).

Follow the instructions on screen and they will ask to confirm details, enter GCSE grades, upload a picture of grades (if external), and then submit the enrolment request.

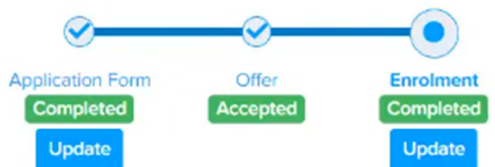

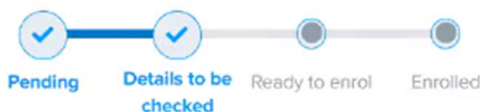
